



Next Time, Ask Your Doctor for an **ELECTRONIC PRESCRIPTION**

What is an Electronic Prescription?

An electronic prescription is a computer-generated prescription sent electronically from your health care provider directly to our pharmacy.

How Does It Work?

Electronic prescriptions are sent using a private, secure and closed network. Your prescription information is not sent over the Internet or as an e-mail.

Why Ask for an Electronic Prescription?

Your electronic prescription is sent immediately to our pharmacy with no need to drop off a paper prescription. Your doctor's electronic system may also be able to suggest generic and other medications, resulting in cost effectiveness. The electronic process also helps prevent medication errors.

Will My Prescription be Ready When I Arrive at the Pharmacy?

Your electronic prescription usually arrives at our pharmacist's computer before you leave your doctor's office. The time needed to prepare your prescription depends on how many other prescriptions are being filled and how soon you arrive. Some pharmacies may not fill your prescription until you arrive, depending on local policy.

As of 1 July 2023, all Colorado Market Health System (CMHS) pharmacies to include, United States Air Force Academy Pharmacies, Peterson Space Force Base Pharmacies, Schriever Space Force Base Pharmacy, Buckley Space Force Base Pharmacy, and Fort Carson Pharmacies, will require electronic prescriptions for controlled medications. Pharmacies will no longer accept routine hard copy prescriptions. To receive your prescriptions quicker, please consider having your provider submit all prescriptions electronically using the sites below:
