Col. Jason C. Williams is a 1999 Distinguished Military Graduate from Prairie View A&M University and was commissioned in the Medical Service Corps. COL Williams' holds a Bachelor of Science Degree in Biology from Prairie View A&M University and a Master of Arts Degree in International Relations from Webster University.

COL Williams most recently successfully commanded the 32d Medical Brigade (Wranglers) and served as Deputy Commanding Officer at Brooke Army Medical Center at Fort Sam Houston, Texas from 2023-2026. He completed Senior Service College and was the US Army War College Fellow assigned to the Department of Veterans Affairs, Washington, D.C., in 2023. He graduated from the Command and General Staff College at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas in 2012.

COL Williams' numerous operational assignments include the 15th Forward Support Battalion (Gamblers), 2nd Brigade (Black Jack), 1st Cavalry Division at Fort Hood, Texas, where he deployed to both Kuwait and Iraq. He also served with the 501st Forward Support Battalion (Providers), 1st Brigade Combat Team (Ready First), 1st Armored Division in Friedberg, Germany, and deployed to Iraq. He served in the 421st Multifunctional Medical Battalion (Vipers), 30th Medical Brigade (Victory Medics) in Wiesbaden, Germany from 2007-2008 as the Battalion Operations Officer. He was also assigned to the 3rd Infantry Division at Fort Stewart, Georgia from 2012-2014, and deployed to Kandahar Airfield, Afghanistan as the Deputy Surgeon. COL Williams served as Division Chief of Medical Operations and Plans for U.S. Special Operations Command in MacDill AFB, Florida from 2018-2020. He successfully commanded the 131st Field Hospital (Guardian Knights), 1st Medical Brigade (Silver Knights), 13th Expeditionary Sustainment Command, Fort Bliss, Texas.

COL Williams' awards and decorations include the Legion of Merit, the Bronze Star Medal with three oak leaf clusters, Defense Meritorious Service Medal with one oak leaf cluster, Meritorious Service Medal with four oak leaf clusters, Army Commendation Medal with three oak leaf clusters, Order of Military Medical Merit and numerous Awards, and Campaign and Service Medals.
